The two will join some 1,500 other students chosen from across the country by other electric co-ops to tour our nation's capital and its historical treasures. Students will also have the opportunity to meet New Mexico's Congressional representatives and state lawmakers to discuss policy issues, including future energy needs.

This year, students were required to compose a full page essay about who their favorite United States president is and why, along with what characteristics or qualities they consider most important in a leader.
