Distribution Maintenance Work in the Animas Area

Columbus Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CEC) has contracted WSI Southwest, Inc., a New Mexico electrical contracting service company, to perform maintenance work on a portion of the distribution system in the Animas area. Maintenance work is being performed in an effort to improve service and reliability.

Work being performed includes the inspection of all poles, inspection of all equipment and connections, tightening of hardware, and replacement of equipment as needed. They began their work on Monday, May 10, 2021 and will continue through the month of June. Contractor vehicles will be clearly marked.

CEC is committed to making continued investments in the distribution system in order to continue to provide our members with safe, reliable, affordable power for the future.
