

CEC Board Approves 2023 Rebates for Members

Columbus Electric Cooperative, Inc., in conjunction with is power supplier, Tri-State Generation & Transmission Association, will continue to partner to offer members rebate programs for 2023!

As a result, the following rebate programs are available to our members:

Appliance Rebates- Includes clothes dryers, induction cooktops, and smart thermostats. You can also get a rebate for recycling your old refrigerator or freezer too!

Electric Motor Rebates- Commercial Motors, Industrial Motors and Variable Speed Drive Retrofit with horsepower from 25 on up.

Heat Pumps, Whole House Fans and Evaporative Cooler Rebates- Includes electric air source and ground source heat pumps.

Outdoor Power Equipment- Includes electric mowers, snow blowers, electric trimmers, chainsaws, power washers, pruners, and blowers.


Water Heater Program- Currently very popular for CEC! Includes 40 gallon and 50 gallon electric water heaters for a very nominal fee.

Members can also get a rebate for **electric bicycles**, **electric forklifts**, and **commercial lighting**.

Members have <u>90</u> days from the date of purchase to apply for a rebate and must provide proof of purchase, so save those receipts!
